OVERVIEW

Are you considering taking your Flight Training one step further towards professional flight qualifications?

We are specialized in providing ATPL distance learning courses approved by GCAA. The program is based on the well-known Bristol Ground School methods for PPL and CPL/IR holders and is distributed in distance learning, class room instruction and examinations.

REQUIREMENTS FOR COURSE ENROLLMENT

- ✈ The applicant shall hold at least an ICAO PPL
- ✈ The applicant must have sufficient knowledge of Mathematics and Physics to facilitate an understanding of the content of the course.
- ✈ All candidates shall have attained a minimum level 4 (four) in English Language Proficiency (ELP).

COURSE DURATION

The average student holding a PPL typically takes six months to complete distance learning studies for the ATPL course, whereas the average student holding a CPL typically takes about 3 months to complete the same studies as elaborated below.

PPL Holders

Module 1 Online Study: Approx. 3 months

Module 1 Refresher Classes: 6 working days

Module 1 Exams: Based on student convenience and readiness (Pls. refer important note below)

Module 2 Online Study: Approx. 3 months

Module 2 refresher Classes: 6 working days

Module 2 Exams: Based on student convenience and readiness (Pls. refer important note below)

CPL/IR License Holders

Online Study: Approx. 3 months

Refresher Classes: 5 working days

Exams: Based on student convenience and readiness (Pls. refer important note below)

IMPORTANT NOTE

Upon registration, students are required to appear on the scheduled refresher course within 12 months from the enrollment date and complete all GCAA examinations within 18 months of the enrollment date. If a student fails to complete the necessary online studies, refresher classes and all the exams within the above periods, it'll be necessary for the student to re-enroll for the course and start afresh. This will include payment of applicable fees for the new course.

Access to Bristol Ground school online question bank is valid for one year. Thereafter, it has to be renewed at personal expense.



TRAINING PROGRAM

A particular advantage of distance learning is that you can work at your own pace. As such, it is ideal for individuals who are working full-time and cannot afford to spare enough time to attend classes regularly. Each course/module is conducted in 3 phases:

- e-Learning Phase i.e. Self-Study
- Contact Classes at FujAA i.e. Refresher Classes
- Internal & GCAA Exams

A. For PPL HOLDERS

The course is 650 hrs. (550 hrs. of distance learning online studies split between M1 and M2 and 100 hrs, of contact classes and exams split between M1 and M2). Each module consists of the following subjects:

MODULE 1

Module 1 contains 8 Subjects



- Meteorology
- General Navigation
- Human Performance
- Instrumentation
- Flight Planning
- Mass and Balance
- VFR Communications
- FR Communications





MODULE 2

Module 2 contains 6 Subjects



- Radio Navigation
- Aircraft General Knowledge
- Aviation Law
- Operational Procedures
- Principles of Flight
- Performance

After enrollment, students can commence distance learning studies using the software access granted to them. To be eligible to attend Refresher Classes for Module 1 for 6 working days at the Academy, the student needs to have:

1. Completed 3 months from the date of commence distance learning studies.
2. Completed 100% of online study and progress tests for Module 1.

To be eligible to attend Refresher Classes for Module 2 for 6 working days at the Academy, the student needs to have:

1. Completed 6 months from the date of commence distance learning studies.
2. Completed Module 1 of the course, including all GCAA exams for Module 1.
3. Completed 100% of online study and progress tests for Module 2.

Note: The examination schedule for both modules is based on student readiness.

B. For ICAO CPL IR HOLDERS

The course is 250hrs (220hrs distance learning and 30hrs class room followed by exams in all ATPL subjects. GCAA CPL/IR license holders are exempted from the Communications examination(s). After enrollment, students can commence distance learning studies using the software access granted to them.

To become eligible to attend Refresher Classes for 5 working days at the Academy, the student needs to have:

1. Completed 3 months from the date of commence distance learning studies.
2. Completed 100% of online study and and all progress tests.

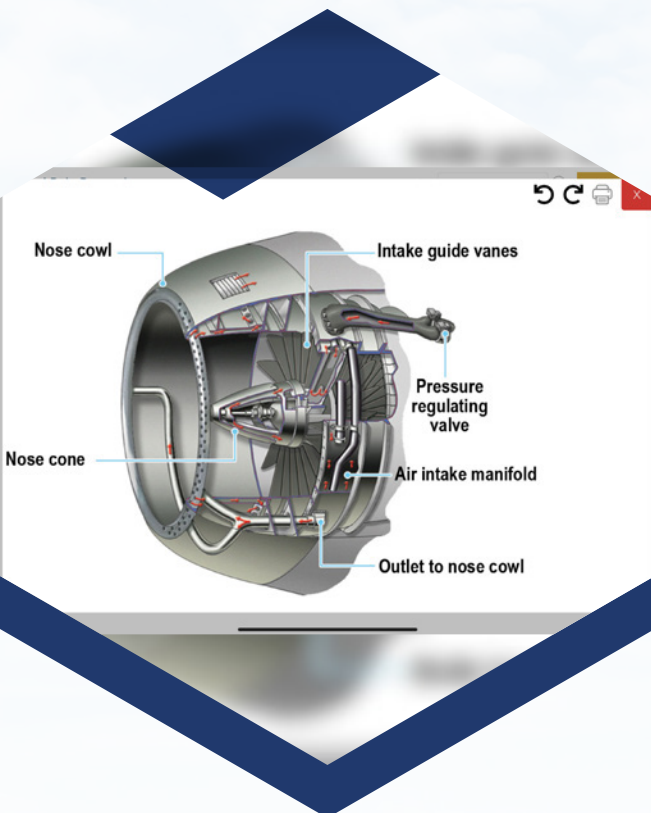
Note: The schedule of the exams is based on student readiness.

THE DISTANCE LEARNING COURSE

After enrollment, the student is provided access to the ATPdigital e-Learning software and question bank developed by Bristol Ground School, UK.

This software is fully compliant with UAE GCAA requirements and learning objectives.

The ATPdigital software is an interactive tool that provides the ATPL student a modern, portable and convenient method of studying for the GCAA ATPL exams. The course is broken down subject by subject and chapter by chapter into easily understood sections supplemented with thousands of diagrams, animations and videos. Progress Tests are given after each major section. These are presented in multiple-choice format, the same as in the GCAA examinations.



In addition to the ATPdigital software, students receive complementary 1-year access to the Bristol Ground School Question Bank. This resource is a comprehensive database for exam-style questions and is kept up-to-date. This provides the ATPL student an invaluable tool to assess their knowledge and practice self-tests before appearing for any ATPL examination. The software is able to score the exams, inform the student of their mistake(s), and provides an explanation of correct answers.

Fujairah Aviation Academy provides ATPL Distance Learning students with an electronic copy of all study material they need gain mastery of the ATPL subjects and become proficient, knowledgeable pilots. 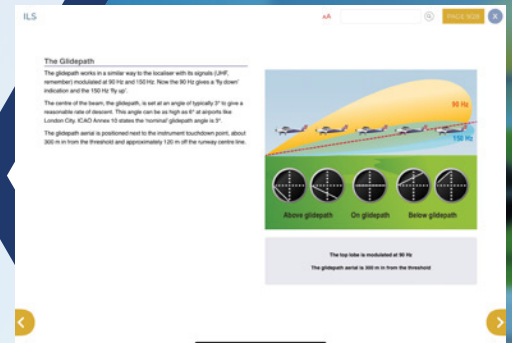
THE TRAINING SOFTWARE

The intuitive and user-friendly software provided with the course contains interactive content alongside text and diagrams. Some of the main features of the software are:

- It provides a complete, modern training solution for the ATPL student.
- It shows at-a-glance information of subject & chapters along with progress and completion status of the student within the course.
- It allows you quickly to find information on specific topics using the search function.
- It tests your knowledge with a series of progress tests and sends your test results back to the school.
- It automatically marks and scores the tests you take.
- It gives you feedback on wrong answers and provides an explanation of the correct answer.
- It tracks and records your responses to questions allowing you to see at-a-glance which questions you got wrong or hesitated over.

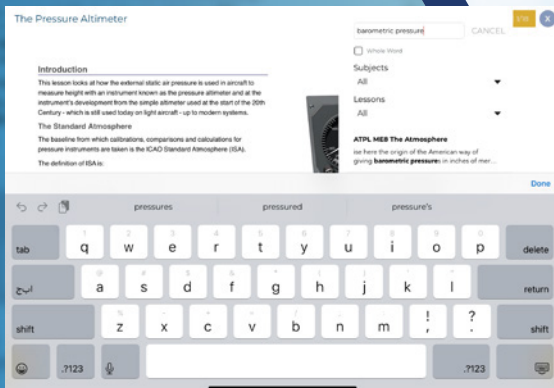
COMPUTER-BASED TRAINING

The computer program normally displays text and images side by side. Images can be expanded for a closer look. Most of the images are vector drawn and can be enlarged as much as you wish. Words in bold font represent key terms crucial to understanding the subject matter.



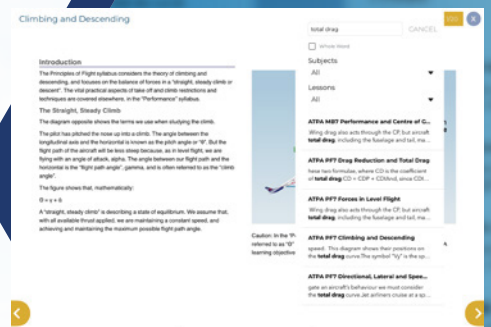
FINDING A TOPIC

The program is designed to help you find information quickly and easily. The computer program is divided by module or subject. Subjects are further sub-divided by chapters in just the same way as one would expect with printed books and manuals.



THE SEARCH FUNCTION

The search function is available within every chapter. If you are not certain which subject and chapter holds the information you seek, you can utilize the search function to quickly locate the required information. Simply type the keyword or phrase inside the search box and tap enter. This features allows rapid searching through the entire course and each subject and displays every page where the word or phrase occurs. Click on the page name to jump straight to your selected topic area.




PROGRESS TESTS

At the end of each lesson is a short quiz containing between two and fifteen questions. Progress tests are inserted at intervals, usually after each group of three to five lessons. These tests can be taken any number of times and the sequence of questions and answers is randomized each time. Each time a test is scored, the program stores the result so that you can automatically transmit it to us over the internet.

TEST REPORT

Once the test is scored, the e-Learning System identifies which questions you got wrong and stores a report with date and time of the test, the name/topic of the test, your score and result. Clicking on the report will take you back to the test that shows each question with the correct answer and the answer you provided.





REFRESHER COURSES

Refreshes courses are held several times a year at Fujairah Aviation Academy. This ensures that the student is able attend refresher classes on dates most convenient to them. Students on the ATPL Distance Learning course holding PPL licenses are required to attend Modules 1 and 2 for 6 working days each as detailed earlier in this document. Students on the ATPL Distance Learning course holding CPL licenses are required to attend refresher classes for 5 working days.

The refresher course classroom phase is an intensive course of study. Much time is spent reviewing key concepts with the instructor, clarifying doubts, working through practice questions and solving any student problems. As a result, there is little time to cover basics or teach new material. Therefore, to get the best out of the refresher course, it is imperative that the student takes the self-study phase very seriously and completes all required online study before attending the refresher course.
